Patna:22.02.2021:

All India Federation of University and College Teachers' Organizations(AIFUCTO) decided massive protest programs against anti people and anti education policy of the Government of India

AIFUCTO expressed serious concern on the rise of price of essential commodities,petrol,gas cylinder consequent upon wrong economic policies of the central government resulting in undue harassment and pain to the common people of India.

AIFUCTO also expressed its deep resentment on the hostile attitude of the NDA Government not responding to the genuine demands of the farmers who are on agitation since long It is also most unfortunate that without caring to the democratic mood of the country the central government has already started implementing the undemocratic, retrograde, unscientific and exclusionary National Education Policy.

AIFUCTO General Secretary Prof.Arun Kumar condemned the collaborative support of the Government of India to go for unbridled privatization and thereby demolishing the public sector contrary to the vision enshrined in our constitution. The National Executive of AIFUCTO which was held in virtual mode on 21.02.2021 reviewed the National dismal scenario, decided to extend solidarity to the ongoing peasant movement, carry on vigorous campaign against undemocratic NEP, oppose steady price rise and to have a one day protest program on the above burning issues in the 3rd week of March by all its affiliates. There will be a massive protest program at New Delhi after academic conferences scheduled to be held on 3rd and 4th April, 2021.

The NEC of AIFUCTO urged upon the state governments of Punjab,Chandigarh, Himachalpradesh for immediate implementation of 7th revised UGC scales of pay,extended solidarity to the cease work program of Manipur college Teachers Associations for implantation of revised UGC scales of pay,condemned the suspension of 16 teachers and employees of Rajendra College Chapra under JP University Bihar,opposed the arbitrary and undemocratic action of VC of Viswabharati University Santiniketan by suspending teachers and employees of the university and urged upon both the authority to rescind the undemocratic action

The NEC decided to have its academic conference on virtual mode on 3rd and 04th April, 2021. The digital conference will be hosted by JAC of Tamil Nadu. They will extend all technical support and have the capacity of 5000 delegates to participate in the conference. The present socio-economic scenario of the nation, impact of covid on higher education, NEP and service condition of teachers and employees will be discussed in the conference. Distinguished scholars and eminent speakers will be invited to the academic conference.

The National Executive has decided to carry on vigorous campaign on burning issues of the nation including Campaign against NEP after exhaustive deliberation in the conference.
